Traffic Safety



Each day 115 people die in traffic accident, that's 1 every 13 minutes. By the time you have finished reading this newsletter 1 person has died in a traffic related accident. When you commit a traffic violation you are violating the law. These laws are made with one thing in mind and that is the safety of all people who use the roadways whether in a vehicle, on a bicycle or on foot. By following these basic driving safety guidelines the number of accidents as well as the injuries and deaths that come with them will be reduced.

- ✓ Use seat belts and child restraint seat properly
- ✓ Drive according to weather and road conditions. Remember the posted speed limit is the maximum speed you may travel under perfect weather and road conditions.
- ✓ Pay attention to your driving. While driving, DO NOT read, DO NOT use a cell phone and DO NOT put on makeup.



- ✓ When riding a motorcycle or bicycle wear a helmet.
 - ✓ Drive defensively and expect the unexpected.
 - ✓ Don't have tunnel vision. Scan the area in front of you for possible hazards including pedestrians and bicyclist.
